Store at temperatures from +5 $^{\circ}$ C to +38 $^{\circ}$ C in a closed packaging.

Warranty period of the water filter operation (excluding the replacement filter cartridges) is 2 years from the purchase date. The manufacturer shall bear no warranty if this product certificate containing dates of manufacturing and/or sale is lost and there

are no other ways to determine the period of the product operation.

The manufacturer shall bear no responsibility in any of the following cases:

- the customer does not follow installation instructions described herein:
- replacement filter cartridges are not replaced in due course after their service life has expired;

INSTALLATION GUIDE

ATTENTION! Only install your filter by a qualified plumber who is certified to perform the installation in accordance with the law of your country.

ATTENTION! Measure the water pressure before installation of the filter. If it exceeds 0.63 MPa (6.3 bar / 91 psi), install a pressure reducing valve (not included in the water filter set).

Water filter installation

1. Select appropriate location for the clean water faucet (not included in the delivery set), water filter (1) and location for the connection unit (3) to the water supply (fig. 1). Note that the connecting tubes should be loose and not bent.

It is recommended to fixate the slack sections of the tubes in such a way as to avoid damaging or connection errors that may reduce the flow rate.

The water filter must be placed at a distance or isolated from any heat sources (kitchen

ovens, boilers, hot water supply pipes. dishwashers or washing machines, etc.).

ATTENTION! The end of the pipeline where the connection is done must be flat.

To prevent damage to the connection unit (3), do not apply significant force during installation.

No reclamations shall be accepted if mechanical damage is done to the connection unit (3) during inappropriate installation.

- 3. Close the cold water supply and discharge pressure by opening the tap.
- 4. Install the connection unit (3) between the cold water supply and the flexible tube (5).



ATTENTION! Wetted tubes are inserted to a stop, minimum depth of 15 mm. Make sure that the tube is properly fixed, it must be secured, it should hold applied force of 80-90 N.

- 5. Install the clean water tap (not included in the delivery set) according to the instructions for the tap.
- 6. Connect the tap with the end of the tube (6) according to the instructions for the tap.

- 7. Place the water filter on the wall.
- 8. After installing the new filter cartridge, flush the water filter in accordance with the section "Flushing the filter".

Cartridge installation

- · Remove protecting film from the new cartridge.
- Insert the cartridge into the housing. to a stop; rotate the cartridge counter clockwise to a click (fig. 3).

ATTENTION! Under-twisting the cartridge to the final position (accompanied by a click) can cause leaks.

FLUSHING THE FILTER

- · Open the cold water supply, make sure the water filter is not leaking.
- · Let the water flow through the water filter for 5 minutes.
- · Close the clean water tap and leave the water filter for 5 minutes
- · Run the water through the water filter again for 5 minutes.
- · Close the clean water tap and make sure that all connections are properly sealed.
- · The water filter is ready for use.

Cartridge replacement

- · Close water before the water filter and open the clean water tap to discharge pressure.
- · Rotate the used cartridge in a counter-




Fig. 2 Fig. 3

- clockwise direction to remove it (fig. 2). Install the new cartridge as described in
- the section "Cartridge installation". · Open the cold water supply, make sure the water filter is not leaking.
- After installing the new cartridge, flush the filter as described in Section "Flushing the filter"

NOTE: If the filter wasn't used for more than 7 days, discard the filtered water for 5 minutes.

In case you're not sure about incoming water bacterial safety, you should boil the filtered water. Filtered water isn't supposed to be kept for a long time. Use fresh filtered water only. Do not expose the water filter to freezing temperatures. During storage, transportation and use of the filter protect it from falls. Do not expose the water filter to freezing temperatures.

Recycle according to local regulations.


